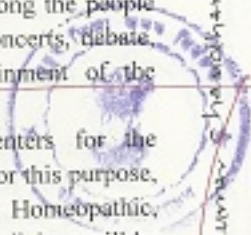

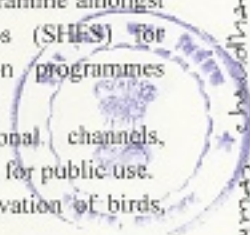
- 3.27. To undertake construction of low-cost houses for the poor in village and towns. To construct public building in urban and rural areas.
- 3.28. The trust will contracts and manage toilet, biogas plants, nonconventional energy centers including wind cycle, hydropower and solar energy on the basis of recent techniques in the rural, urban, semi urban and tribal areas with the help of the State Government and Central Government or other legal authority.

- 3.37. To accept donation, in cash or kind, subscriptions, grants, presents and to collect dividends rents, interest and other income of the TRUST FUND etc, for being utilized to further the objects thereof.

4. MANAGEMENT OF TRUST:

The general management of the Trust for the purpose of managing the affairs and properties and carrying out the objects of the Trust aforesaid shall be vested in the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall have one Chairman. The Chairman shall be Sri Satish Kumar Chaudhary who will hold office of the Chairman for life.

Thereafter the existing Trustees and without prejudice to the generality of the objects and powers above mentioned, they shall have powers to do all or any of the following that is to say-

- 4.1. To enter into contracts and borrow money from Bank institution or individuals for the purpose of the Trust and management of its properties and assets.
- 4.2. To appoint officers and staff at such remuneration, if any, as they think fit.
- 4.3. To appoint consultants for specific purpose on such terms and conditions as they may deem fit.
- 4.4. To enter into agreement with organizations and individuals for execution of any projects that may be undertaken over by the Trust from time to time.
- 4.5. To make rules and regulations from time to time for the management and conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its properties and assets.
- 4.6. The number of trustees shall not be less than three and not more than seven. The trustees shall be trustees for their life time, but any trustees may

resign by giving notice in writing to his co-trustees and shall also cease to be trustee if requested in writing by three-fourth of the remaining trustees, either to fill up a vacancy or as additional trustee, shall be by resolution of the Trustees.

5. POWER OF TRUSTEES:

The Trustees will also have the following powers:

- 5.1. To apply the whole or part of the income or accumulate thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the trust properties for one or more of the objectives of the trust as the Trustees may from time to time determine.
- 5.2. To amalgamate the Trust with any other Trust or Charity for wholly public charitable purpose.
- 5.3. To convert and get in the Trust properties and/or to vary the investments for the time being.
- 5.4. To invest and keep invested the trust properties in the purchase of immovable property or in other assets specified in Section 11(5) of Income Tax Act, 1961 and to alter, vary and transpose such investment from time to time as the trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit. In any case the funds of the Trust shall not be invested in any of the manner, which is not permissible, by relevant provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 applicable at any given time.
- 5.5. The Trust Committee consisting of Trustees shall have power to sell or assign any movable and immovable property or properties for the time being forming part of the Trust fund either together or in parcels and either by public auction or private contract and other with or without any special or other stipulations as to title, evidence or

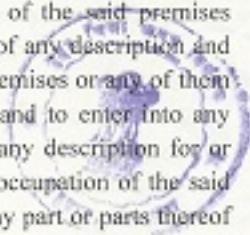

- 5.6. To invert, dispose off, transfer and otherwise deal with the subject matter of the Trust in such manner, as the Trustees deem fit and proper to do carrying out the objects of the trust.
- 5.7. To open accounts with any Bank or Post office for the purpose of keeping the moneys of the Trust to operate such accounts including over-draft accounts and to give instructions to the Bank or post office and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts by one or most constituted attorneys/agents appointed by the Trustees.
- 5.8. To appoint, constitute attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested in them under these presents for time to time and remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in their places.
- 5.9. To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the managements of the affairs thereof and of running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.
- 5.10. To set apart the whole or part of the income of the corpus or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.
- 5.11. It shall be lawful for the Trustees to settle and determine all matters of interpretation of THESE

amalgamated with the Trust, created by THESE PRESENTS to intent and effect that such other Trust, Institution or Charity shall be deemed to be a part and parcel of the Trust of THESE PRESENTS, provided that no conditions are accepted which involves a change in the name of the Trust or are insistent with or repugnant to the objects thereof.

- 5.15. To pay all costs, charges and expenses incidental to the management, administration and execution of the trustees and powers herein contained.
- 5.16. To purchase or hire or to take on lease lands, buildings and other immovable and movable properties in the name of the Trust.
- 5.17. To raise or borrow moneys required for the purpose of the Trust on mortgage or pledge of the Trust Estate or any part thereof with or without any security and at such rate of interest and on such terms & conditions as the trustees shall think fit.
- 5.18. To do such acts and things which may be incidental and necessary to attain the objectives of the Trust.

6. DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

- 6.1. The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and fund that shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, with whom the trust proper ties or any other securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their willful neglect or default.
- 6.2. All the trustees shall be bound to maintain and defend all such suits, and (subject to the provision of this deed) to take such other steps as may be reasonably requisite for the preservation of the

- 6.3. The trustees shall be bound to deal with the trust property as carefully as a man ordinary prudence to deal with such property if it were their own, and, in the absence of contract to the contrary, as trustees so dealing shall not be responsible for the loss, destruction or deterioration of the trust property.
- 6.4. If trustees shall be destructive or permanently injurious to the trust property, the remaining trustees shall be bound to take measures to prevent such act.

- 7.3. The trustees may from time to time frame scheme, rules, regulations, laws and byelaws for regulating the affairs of the projects undertaken by the Trust in pursuance to the various objects. Such rules as framed by the Board of Trustees for the conduct of affairs of the project shall be binding and no deviation shall be permissible in any of the rules so framed by any authority whatsoever connected with the said product without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees.

The receipt of a person authorized by the trustees or a resolution of the Board of the Trustees of any money paid or any property transferred or delivered to the Trustees in execution of any of the trust or power thereof or for the purchase of any property authorized to be sold shall effectually discharge any

8. INDEMNITY OF TRUSTEES ETC:

- 9.2. Resolution passes without any meeting of the Trustees and evidence in writing under the hands of three-fourth of the Trustees or the number nearest thereto shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at the meeting of the trustees.
- 9.3. The existing Trustees may appoint one or more Trustees at their discretion from time to time, but in
